Return the Individual Merit Badge Registration Form attached to this application.

3. BSA Medical Form: All campers must have an annual health history (attested by parents/guardians if under 18) with an attached copy of a physician-conducted medical exam given less than 36 months ago. No scout will be admitted to camp without complying with this requirement. The BSA Class 1 and Class 2 medical forms should be used, which includes authorization for medical treatments, signed by the Scout's parent or guardian. Bring your medical form to camp.
