Dear Parents:

Our unit will be attending Sand Hill Scout Reservation from _____ to _____. I hope that your Scout will be able to camp with us because summer camp is a special place, where excitement fills the day, new skills are learned, and new friends are made. The camp program features something for everyone; first year campers, experienced campers, and leaders all have fun at summer camp.

The cost for each Scout camper this year is \$130, but if paid before May 1, you save \$10. Our unit recommends that you and your Scout save for summer camp all year long. The following savings plan, which is not mandatory, ensures that your Scout can afford summer camp:

November 1, 2001 (save \$25; \$25 total)

February 1, 2002 (save \$25; \$80 total)

December 1, 2001 (save \$25; \$50 total)

March 1, 2002 (save \$25; \$105 total)

January 1, 2002 (save \$5; \$55 total)

April 1, 2002 (save \$25; \$130 total)

Each Scout must bring with him a current BSA medical form (Class 1 and 2) complete and signed by his physician and parent. No Scout will be allowed to participate in summer camp without this medical form. A blank medical form is enclosed for you to complete.
